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- All students have been distributed 25 raffle tickets that are to be sold for \$10/per ticket.
- Students who sell their allotted number of tickets will earn a “raffle free day” on Wednesday, October 9th and will be excused from school on this day.
- If a student does not sell their allotted number of tickets, they can fulfill their philanthropy requirement by attending school on Wednesday, October 9th and participating in a school wide philanthropy project. **No college visits, sick days or call-ins will be accepted.**
- Once a student sells a minimum of 12 tickets they have earned the opportunity to be out of dress code for the duration of the student raffle.
- There is a “multi-student discount” for families with more than one child currently attending Cathedral. Please reference the chart below to see how many tickets students are required to sell to meet their philanthropy requirement:
 - 1 student – 25 tickets
 - 2 students – 40 tickets
 - 3 students – 50 tickets
 - 4+ students – 55 tickets
- Proceeds from the student raffle are used to support the need-based tuition assistance program and approved CHS teams/clubs/organizations.
- Students can turn in their sold raffle tickets to Mr. Fogel directly (room #4335) or to their “C” period teacher on the dates below:
