\*\* This income is 125% of the federal Reduced Lunch program income limit. Families qualifying at this level qualify for a Choice Scholarship at 70% of the per-pupil funding based upon the family's school district of residence.

\*\*\* This income is 150% of the federal Reduced Lunch program income limit. Families qualifying at this level qualify for a Choice Scholarship at 50% of the per-pupil funding based upon the family's school district of residence.

\*\*\*\* This income is 200% of the federal Reduced Lunch program income limit. Families at or below this level qualify for an SGO Scholarship. Families of continuing Choice Scholarship recipients and/or the Special Education Track qualifying at this level qualify for a Choice Scholarship at 50% of the per-pupil funding based upon the family's school district of residence.
