Cathedral Core 40 Diploma

- 10 credits of English:
 - 8 credit of English 9/10/11/12 + 1 credit Composition/Journalistic Writing + 1 credit Debate/Speech
- 8 credits of Math
- 8 credits of Theology
- 6 credits of Science:
 - 2 credits Biology + 2 credits Chemistry/Physics + 2 credits science electives
- 6 credits of Social Studies:
 - 2 credits World History + 2 credits US History + 1 credit Government + 1 credit Economics
- 3 credits of Physical Education:
 - 1 credit General P.E. + 1 credit elective P.E. + 1 credit Health
- 4 credits of World Language (*Must be 2 consecutive years of one language)
- 2 credits of Fine Arts (Music/Choir, Theatre, & Visual Arts courses)
- 3 credits of Elective course (your choice!)
- Service Hours (all 4 years)

<u>Core 40 with Academic Honors Dipl</u>

Cathedral Core 40 requirements

- 2 additional credits in World Language
 3 years of one language OR
 2 consecutive years of a language & 2 consecutive years of a nother
- Semester grades must be at a C- or higher Cumulative grade point average must be a 3.0 at graduation

 - Complete 6 college credits worth of dual credit coursework \succ
 - Earn a composite score of 1250 or higher on the SAT \succ
 - Minimum score of 560 on the Math section 0
 - Minimum score of 590 on the Critical Reading & Ο Writing sections
 - Earn a composite score of 26 on the ACT & complete the \succ writing section
 - Earn 2 of the following: \succ
 - 3 college credit worth of dual credit coursework 0
 - 2 semesters of AP credit & complete corresponding exams Ο
 - 2 semesters of IB credit & complete corresponding exams Ο
