We welcome students of all abilities and skills, and we work to emphasize performance fundamentals, strive to develop musical talents and skills, and enrich students' lives by giving an appreciation for other cultures through the use of music from many genres.

Marching Band and Guard

The "Pride of the Irish" is the largest and most visible Cathedral band program. All band students also participate in Concert Band, Pep Band, and ISSMA District Solo and Ensemble Contest. The marching band has been a traditional favorite at the Indianapolis Veterans Day Parade and St. Patrick's Day Parade. Over the past 22 years, the band has also performed in Louisville, KY; Chicago, IL; Cincinnati, OH; Disneyland, Anaheim, CA; Disney World, Orlando, FL; on a Royal Caribbean cruise; Toronto, Canada; Honolulu, HI, and Dublin, Ireland. The "Pride" has performed at district, regional and state marching band competitions, festivals, and athletic events. In the past 22 years, they have received the highest Group I ratings at all Indiana district marching and concert contests. Many of our outstanding musicians are selected each year to participate in the ISSMA State Solo and Ensemble Contest, the Ball State University High School Honor Band, the IMEA Honor Band, the Indiana All-Star Marching Band and the Indiana All-State Band.

Orchestra

The Cathedral Orchestra is a challenging and fun program designed

to enhance each student's understanding of and appreciation for different types of music. No matter the level of your student, the Orchestra offers students the opportunity to learn, improve, and excel. Orchestra students enjoy unique educational opportunities, such as going to the International Violin Competition every four years, and even bringing in a finalist from the competition to teach a master-class. The CHS Orchestra gives back to the community by performing annually at the Cathedral Soup Kitchen.

Cathedral students may also choose to participate in Jazz Ensemble, which offers exposure to yet another type and form of music.

With nearly 110 musicians and guard members each year, our marching band entertains crowds at football games and Indianapolis parades, our pep band brings spirit and enthusiasm to girls' and boys' basketball games and our concert band takes the stage in December and May for Christmas and Spring musical galas.

"The Pride of the Irish" is the instrumental musical ambassador for Cathedral High School with a large number of performance opportunities for the students. Concerts and Performances

Cathedral bands and ensembles are showcased in three shows annually, and student talents are utilized at the annual ShamrAuction, Cathedral's premiere fundraising event. Additionally, the groups are invited to perform at functions and events throughout the city.
