


Setting up your Cathedral Email Account

 To setup your school email account, on a computer, open a browser and go to mail.gocathedral.com:


- 2. You will then enter your first initial, middle initial (if you have one), lastname and "24" (or whatever your graduating year is) in this format: althornsbury20. Then press "Next"
- 3. Your temporary login password is: chsirish Then press "Next":

 You will then see a disclaimer page, please choose "Accept": A few of you will not see this step. It's ok.




 Once you login, you'll see a pop-up that will allow you to choose your view of your inbox.
 Just press Next until this box goes away: A few of you will not see this step. It's ok.


6. Now you are signed in. The next steps will be to change your generic password. This is required:

In the top right hand of the screen, you will see a box with your initial. Click on the box and then choose "Manage your Google Account":


On the left hand side, choose "Security":



Under the "Signing into Google" section, click on "Password":



You'll now be prompted to change your password. Please choose a new password that is at least 8 characters. To make your password more secure, make sure you have at least 1 capital letter, and 1 number (more is better): PLEASE RECORD THIS PASSWORD SOMEWHERE.









Powerschool Parent Accounts

Each parent will have the ability to create their own Powerschool parent account. These accounts will not be needed until late July or early August for the fall semester. We will be emailing you specific instructions with the correct ID and password that will be required at a later time. This is just a sample of the instructions so that you can familiarize yourself with the steps. 
1) To create your account on Cathedral's Powerschool, (https://powerschool.cathedral-irish.org) (Only do this if you never created a Cathedral Parent Powerschool account)



2) Fill out the information in the top box "Create Account" (This will be your login once its created)



- 3) In the "Link Students to Account" section, enter your child's name (Students Name)
- 4) Enter the Access ID: (Parent Access ID) (THIS IS CASE SENSITIVE)

- 5) Enter the Access Password: (4 Digit Parent Code)
- 6) Enter the relationship with your child, then press Enter at the bottom of the screen.

Once your account is created, you can go here to access your child's grades (Or go to our website, click on Parents, Powerschool Grades)

If you already have an existing Powerschool account:

- 1) Log into your Powerschool account
- 2) Go to Account Preferences on the left
- 3) Click on the Students Tab
- 4) Click the "Add" button in the upper right of the screen
- 5) Enter your students name along with the Access ID and Password listed above, include the relationship, and press "Submit"

If you forgot your login ID or password to Powerschool:

- 1) Click on the following link to recover your login ID or password
- 2) Your password or login ID will be emailed to your registered password
- 3) If you cannot recover either your login account or password, please email powerschool@gocathedral.com

iPad Specifications and Recommendations For Cathedral Students

All students will need their iPad for summer school classes. If you do not have an iPad yet, you should order it as soon as possible. Students should have their iPads the week before (May 26) summer school starts for onboarding purposes. The technology Team recommends that iPads are 7th Generation 10.2" WiFi IPad with 128G storage with some sort of case. You can get 6th generation as well, just make sure you get the 128G version to ensure that your freshman has enough space. 32G models may work for the beginning of your students High School career, but will start to run out of memory as they use it through the years.

****** iPad Minis are not accepted because they do not work with online state testing ******

Incoming freshmen and new students to Cathedral High School enrolled in Summer School must have their iPad "onboarded" before classes start on June 2. Onboarding is the process where our technology department connects your device with all the applications that will be needed for your classes. On May 26, all new families will receive information from our technology team on how to onboard their iPad.

How to create a new Apple ID

Use the same Apple ID to enjoy all Apple services. Find out how to create one.


An Apple ID is the account you use to access Apple services like iCloud, the App Store, the iTunes Store, Apple Music, and more. It includes the email address and password that you use to sign in, and all the contact, payment, and security details that you'll use across Apple services.

No matter where you create your Apple ID, just remember to use the same one to sign in to every Apple service. That way, you can access and manage everything with a single account and password.

Create an Apple ID on your computer

Create an Apple ID on your Mac

- 1. Open the App Store.
- 2. Click Sign In, then click Create Apple ID. If you don't see this option, make sure you're signed out of iCloud.



- 3. Read and agree to the Terms and Conditions.
- 4. Complete the form to create your new Apple ID. The email address you provide will be your new Apple ID.
- 5. After you've filled out the form, click Continue. If you see a message that says that the email address you entered is already associated with an Apple ID, follow these instructions to use an existing Apple ID instead.
- 6. Enter your credit card and billing information, then click Continue. You can also choose None, and learn what to do if None isn't showing or you can't select it. We'll charge you only when you make a purchase. You can change or remove your payment details later.
- 7. Check your email for a verification email from Apple and follow the steps to verify your email address.

After you verify your email address, you can use your new Apple ID to sign in to the App Store and other Apple services such as iCloud.

Create an Apple ID on your Windows PC

- 1. Open iTunes for Windows. Make sure that you have the latest version.
- 2. From the menu bar at the top of your computer screen or at the top of the iTunes window, choose Account > Sign In. Then click Create New Apple ID.
- 3. Read and agree to the Terms and Conditions and Apple Privacy Policy.
- 4. Complete the form to create your new Apple ID. The email address you provide will be your new Apple ID. The form also includes security questions for your protection.
- 5. After you've filled out the form, click Continue. If you see a message that says that the email address you entered is already associated with an Apple ID, follow these instructions to use an existing Apple ID instead.
- 6. Enter your credit card and billing information, then click Continue. You can also choose None, and learn what to do if None isn't showing or you can't select it. We'll charge you only when you make a purchase. You can change or remove your payment details later.
- 7. Check your email for a verification email from Apple and follow the steps to verify your email address.

Create an Apple ID on another device

To create an Apple ID on an Apple TV, Android device, smart TV, or streaming device, you can usually follow the steps provided onscreen and enter your full name, date of birth, an email address or phone number, and a payment method. You need to create an Apple ID when you subscribe to services like Apple Music and Apple TV, or when you download the Apple TV app. If you set up the Apple TV app on your smart TV and need to create an Apple ID, you might be redirected to activate apple com.

Create an Apple ID on the web

If you have trouble, try using the steps below to create your Apple ID on the web.

1. Go to the Apple ID account page and click Create your Apple ID.



- Enter your name, birthday, email, password, and choose the country or region that
 matches the billing address for your payment method. The email address you
 provide will be your new Apple ID.*
- Select your security questions, and then check the boxes to subscribe to Apple
 Updates if you'd like. This keeps you up to date on the latest news, software,
 products, and services from Apple.
- 4. Click Continue.

After you create your Apple ID on the web, you can upgrade to Apple's highest level of security, two-factor authentication, if you're eligible. After you verify your email address, you can use your new Apple ID to sign in to the iTunes Store and other Apple services such as iCloud.

If you see a message that you need to sign in to iTunes

If you created a new Apple ID on the web and see a message that you need to sign in to iTunes, follow the steps below for your device:

- On an iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch: Open Settings, then tap "Sign into device" and sign in with your Apple ID.
- On a Mac: Choose Apple menu > System Preferences, then select Apple ID and sign in with your Apple ID.
- On an Apple TV: Sign in to the App Store, iTunes Store, or Apple Music with your Apple ID.
- On a PC: Sign in to iTunes with your Apple ID.
- On an Android device: Sign in to Apple Music on Android with your Apple ID.
