The successful candidate will have extensive knowledge of Science content as well as experience working with students at the High School level. This position is an integral part of Cathedral High School's Science Department and will require the candidate to create a welcoming and engaging classroom environment for all students. As a physics teacher you are responsible for teaching students physics laws in a very understandable manner. You are responsible for preparing engaging sessions making the students enthralled in physics. To be successful in this role, you should possess a thorough understanding of various physics concepts and theories. You should promote a positive, purposeful and professional working atmosphere that encourages cooperation and challenge whilst valuing the contribution that individuals make to the success of the department.
