A FEW "THINKS" FROM THE AUTHORS

WHAT IS SEUSSICAL?

This is a new musical, based on the works of Dr. Seuss. But it isn't just a string of his stories set to music. And it isn't just one of his stories. In fact, what we've done is to create a totally new, full-length book musical, with a story which weaves together his most famous tales and characters in unexpected ways. The Seuss lexicon includes hundreds upon hundreds of wondrous characters, creatures, places and things. "Seussical" incorporates elements from at least 15 of his books, as well as many of his best-loved and most familiar characters. Many of these characters never met one another before. But they meet in our musical. And in the course of the evening, some will fall in love, some will have desperate adventures and some will save the world. And they'll all travel everywhere from the Jungle of Nool to McEligott's Pool to Palm Beach.

Dr. Seuss believes in helping a friend, in not giving up, in keeping a promise. He believes in the value and dignity of others, in working to preserve the fragile sweetness of the natural world, and he believes that peace is the ultimate ideal, among nations and in every heart. He also believes in the pure power of the imagination. You will find all these serious concerns at the heart of "Seussical."

A LITTLE ABOUT OUR CHARACTERS:

THE CAT IN THE HAT is the essence of mischief, fun and imagination. THE CAT stirs things up, causes trouble, but always sets things right again, helping JOJO to discover the power of his own imagination as they create the story for the show together. Look for a physically adept actor (male or female) to play the Cat, one who will be able to play many comic cameos and is comfortable improvising with an audience.

JOJO is a "Thinker", a smart child with a wild imagination. He can be played as being a little bit awkward, a little bit of a loner, or simply a rambunctious kid whose Thinks get him into constant trouble. By the end of the show, he learns what it means to be a responsible member of his world, using the power and possibilities of his own Thinks.

HORTON THE ELEPHANT. A gentle giant, rotund and appealing. Think of him as a big-hearted blue collar guy who is steadfast and responsible and always tries to do the right thing for his friends. He is imaginative and receptive to the world around him. He is very un-self-conscious. Horton's view of the world never changes—he believes in its goodness. But by the end of the show, without even realizing it, he is ready to become a parent.

GERTRUDE McFUZZ. Very self-conscious and aware that her one-feather tail isn't perfect. Gertrude changes during the show from a vain, neurotic, nervous and shy bird into one with the power to protect and care for a baby elephant bird and commit herself to Horton. In other words, she stops worrying about her looks and grows up.

MAYZIE LA BIRD. Self-centered, selfish and vain, Mayzie will never admit to her own flaws. She manipulates anyone she can (especially Horton) into doing what she wants. But Mayzie isn't all bad. In giving up her egg to Horton once and for all, she has a moment of generosity—she realizes she isn't the kind of person who'd be a good parent, and she does the best thing she can for the egg.

SOUR KANGAROO. She isn't really sour at all. She's just got a lot of attitude. She's loud, brassy and a lot of fun.

GENERAL GENGUS KHAN SCHMITZ. General Schmitz is bursting with pride at the military academy he runs, and the boys he turns out. He is not sadistic, mean or abusive. He is proud! He is doing the right thing for his boys! He is making the world a better place! This makes him a comic character, because it's clear he's so misguided. Please don't play him as a villain or bully. By the end of the show, he's discovered that making war may not be the right thing to do, and that adults can learn from children as well.

THE WICKERSHAM BROTHERS. These are not bad guys! They're simply a lot like kids who tease, play pranks and get a kick out of making mischief, although often at others' expense. They enjoy hanging around with one another, making music together on the street corner, and playing off one another. Encourage each of your actors to find his own Wickersham persona.

THE WHOS. They're a lot like you and me only so small as to be invisible. Don't think of them as cute midgets or weird little aliens. They should be played for their inherent humanity. This goes for MR. and MRS. MAYOR, who are parents trying hard to raise a difficult child in a difficult world. They may get aggravated with Jojo, but they love him dearly and try to do the right thing, even if it turns out to be a mistake. Encourage everyone playing a Who to try and create his or her own, unique character.

JUNGLE CREATURES. No matter how these actors are costumed, please ask each one to create a distinct human persona. They are real people at heart, just like us, even though they may be described as animal characters. We discourage masks and literal "animal costumes." Be imaginative. Be wild. Be simple.

A FEW TECHNICAL NOTES:

Every production has the option to use a male or a female actor to play THE CAT IN THE HAT.

For a MALE CAT IN THE HAT, please follow the script as written. The musical score is labeled "Male Version" in the upper right hand corner of every page of each cue that is intended for a MALE CAT IN THE HAT and the orchestra parts are labeled "Male Version" as well.

For a FEMALE CAT IN THE HAT, please use the <u>additional scene in Palm Beach</u>, which is included at the end of the script and marked for "Female Cat in the Hat." This is the only text change necessary to accommodate a female. The musical score is labeled "Female Version" in the upper right hand corner of every page of each cue that is intended for a FEMALE CAT IN THE HAT and the orchestra parts are labeled "Female Version" as well.

These above cues reflect changes in the vocal ranges and vocal arrangements as well as the orchestration and instrumental arrangement. Lyrics and texts are identical with the exception of the Palm Beach scene (#21) as mentioned above.

All other musical cues can be played by a cast that features either a MALE or FEMALE CAT IN THE HAT.

SOME THOUGHTS ON HOW TO DO THE SHOW:

Our show has been through many different versions in its writing and in production. From its original reading in New York to its Toronto Workshop, through its Broadway run and on to two successful national tours, a number of talented designers, directors and choreographers have tried their hands at creating the world of Dr. Seuss. We've all learned a lot along the way, but we can sum it up in three words: LESS IS MORE!

If you want to do your production on a gym floor in sweatpants and colorful T-shirts, with a ladder for a tree and a few simple props and feathers, please go right ahead and do it. The show will work--beautifully! Don't think you need anything more elaborate. The simpler and more imaginative your production is, the more the story will come shining through. After all, this is a story about the imagination. Use yours.

As for choreography, yes, you guessed it--LESS IS MORE! Dr. Seuss is all about language, and so is "SEUSSICAL". We've noticed that the more complicated and busy the choreography is, the more difficult it becomes to follow the story, which is dense and told mostly in song. If you tell the story clearly and simply, sing with precision, use minimal sets, props and costumes, and don't over-choreograph, you will have a wonderful production and more fun that you can imagine.

(CAT holds the microphone to the clover for a beat)

Nothing! Stay tuned! We'll be right back!

(The CAT now interviews GERTRUDE MCFUZZ, a plain bird with a onefeather tail)
