

## **COVID-19 SAFETY AND WELLNESS NOTICE**

Cathedral High School plans to conduct live/in-person/on-campus classes, athletic and other extracurricular events, meetings, daycare services, and other business connected with the 2020/2021 School Year (Activities). Please know Cathedral has developed plans and procedures to reduce the risks of exposure to COVID-19 associated with attendance at all Activities and all staff and attendees are expected to comply with those plans. The procedures are based on numerous sources, including guidance from the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and applicable state and local public health agencies. While at Cathedral High School, please wear a mask at all times, comply with posted and governmental recommended social distancing guidelines (i.e., 6-feet), avoid handshakes, and regularly and thoroughly wash your hands. We also ask you to cooperate with additional requests or guidance from Cathedral representatives for specific events or situations.

Before coming to Cathedral High School for any activity or reason, please assess your own health as well as those of any minors you will be accompanying. If you experience 2 or more unexplained symptoms listed below or have had close contact with or cared for someone medically diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last 14 days, please do not attend the activity.

- Fever greater than 100 degrees
- Cough
- Congestion/runny nose
- Diarrhea
- Nausea / vomiting
- Sore throat
- Muscle Pain

- Fatigue
- Chills
- Red Eves
- Shortness of breath / trouble breathing
- New loss of taste or smell
- Or any symptoms added by the CDC

The School makes health and safety a priority for all, both through its current COVID-19 Mitigation Plan(s) and other good-faith efforts. However, COVID-19 by nature spreads easily and sustainably, and public health authorities guidance emphasizes the risk of exposure in large group settings.
